**Attorney & Privacy Expert Mari J. Frank to Present Continuing

A former victim of identity theft herself, Attorney Frank has testified many times on privacy and identity theft issues in the California legislature and in the US Congress. In May 1999, she was summoned to the White House to a press conference with President Clinton to speak on Consumer Privacy. Her speech was broadcast on C-SPAN TV. Her 90 minute PBS Television special, *“Identity Theft: Protecting Yourself in the Information Age,”* has aired nationwide.
